We invite you to the Tri-County Fair held July 13 - 16, 2017. **Sunday, July 16** will be the livestock show for **swine, sheep, kiddie show, beef, dairy and goats – please note this is the new show order this year.** This show is open to any youth and is a sanctioned show for ND Jr. point association members. Check-in with Crystal and livestock on grounds by **Saturday at 7 p.m.** There is also a small animal show (poultry, cats, dogs, & rabbits) held Saturday at 4:30 p.m.

This year's entertainment at the fair includes racing events along with a ranch rodeo with live music to follow. Go to www.tricofair.com for a more detailed fair schedule.

Fairground Updates and Camping!!!

Based on your feedback we have updated electrical outlets, added exhaust fans to the livestock barn, provided camper hook-ups near the barn and are hoping to upgrade the washrack this year! Livestock exhibitors can bring a camper with first come first serve parking in designated spaces and access to electricity (bring plenty of extension cords). There will be a \$20 fee to camp – pay Crystal.

Other information -

- **NEW: Entries received after Tuesday, July 11 will incur a \$30 late fee. It is easier to delete entries than add them the week of the show so please register early!**
- Exhibited livestock will be evaluated at check-in. Any sick animals should not be unloaded and will be sent home immediately. Out of state exhibitors should have accompanying health certificate(s).
- All market animals, sheep and swine must be tagged. Sheep and goats need scrapie tags.
- Poultry must be banded or have appropriate forms.
- All registered animals must have registration papers in hand at check-in.
- Ethical fitting and treatment of livestock will be enforced.
- We have a **kiddie show** for our younger exhibitors – they can show anything they would like! This will be held following the sheep show on Sunday. No age limit and every participant is a winner!
- Breakfast is available on the fairgrounds Sunday morning at 8 a.m. and there is a free picnic lunch for livestock exhibitors and their families.

- * No entry fees (**\$30 late fee for entries after July 11**)
- * Exhibitor provides own bedding
- * Classes are the same as the 2017 ND State Fair 4-H book
- * Preteen (0 - 13 years) & Teen (14-21 years) Showmanship Contest and Round Robin
- * Livestock release time will be 1 hour after the completion of your last species show on Sunday

Early outs will forfeit premiums.

Saturday, July 15 Schedule

- * 4:30 p.m. – Small animal entry and judging
(pre-register in the livestock barn on the sign-up sheets)
- * 7:00 p.m. – Livestock are required to be at the fairgrounds and checked in with the barn superintendent.
- * 8:00-9:00 p.m. – Weigh Market Livestock

Sunday, July 17 Schedule

New * 8:00 a.m. – Swine, Sheep, Kiddie Show, Beef, Dairy, Goat shows held in this order.

- * 12:00 – Free Bag Lunch for Exhibitors & Families

Cow/Calf Pairs & Kiddie Show – Don't forget about the open class cow/calf pairs and/or kiddie show exhibitors. Pairs can be purebred or commercial, don't need to be groomed or halter broke, and will be shown in their pens inside the livestock barn. Make sure to register pairs so we set up enough pens. The kiddie show will be held after the sheep show. Youth can show anything they wish – everyone is a winner!

Swine Exhibitors – We are limited to 18 pens. Pens will be assigned as entries arrive.
